WHY CHARTERERS' LIABILITY COVER?



Many charterers appear in the B/L, C/P and/or other contracts related to the ship and voyage. Consequently, they may become involved in related disputes. Further, as a charterer you may face liabilities such as:

- Cargo claims, e.g. contamination, shortage etc
- Damage to hull, e.g.
 - > bad bunkers
 - > damages caused during loading or discharging
 - > unsafe port etc
- Personal injury claims
- Oil pollution
- General average
- Wreck removal

Please note that as a trader carrying your own cargo, you may also be exposed to all liabilities listed above, except for the liabilities related to the cargo.

WHY SKULD?

- Charterers' Liability for Pollution when carrying own cargo
- Comprehensive SOL Insurance – if deviating from obligations towards cargo
- Breaches of Contract of Carriage of Cargo
- Carriage of Cargo on Deck with Under Deck B/L
- Through Transit Liabilities for Cargo and Third Party
- Extended Cargo Liability Insurance
- Carriage of Ad Valorem Cargo – covers the difference between the limitation and the actual value of the cargo
- Carriage of Cash, Bullion etc as Cargo
- Liability as Bailee of Cargo – storage of cargo in excess of 21 days for tankers
- Storage of Cargo in Excess of 21 days (other than tankers)
- Kidnap and Ransom Insurance, including loss of hire extension
- Bunkers insurance
- Containers & Container Liability
- Cargo-handling Equipment & Liability
- Charterers' Comprehensive Cover (CCC) – tailor-made package according to clients' needs
